Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) for Experienced Traffic Controllers and Traffic Management Implementers


Overview

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) is an assessment pathway that identifies whether the skills, knowledge and experience you have gained through formal, informal and non formal learning, work experience, life experience or community involvement align with those required by one or more units of competency in the Skill Set for which you are seeking RPL.

The evidence you are providing must be current which means you are currently working (or have worked in the past 12 months) in the relevant role on the specific Category roads.

Workers with current WZTM tickets have until 1st February 2027 to complete recognition of prior learning. To apply for RPL, applicants must meet the Learner Entry requirements listed in the relevant Skill Set.

On successful completion of the RPL Assessment Pathway:

ATC will issue the applicants with:

· Statement of Attainment



<u>NOTE:</u> Applicants will also be required to successfully complete the training and assessment for the SA Localised content prior to applying for the relevant TTM Ticket issued by the Department for Infrastructure and Transport (DIT).

Temporary Traffic Management (TTM) categories:

TTM Category 1 is inclusive of single carriageway roads with a posted speed limit of:

- less than 60 km/h where the AADT is less than 10,000, or
- 110 km/h or less where the AADT is less than 3,000.

TTM Category 2 comprises:

- any signalised intersection, or
- multiple lanes in a single direction (excluding overtaking and turn lanes), or
- anything not in TTM Category 1 or TTM Category 3.

TTM Category 3 comprises:

- · expressways (i.e., freeway, motorway, or tunnel) and associated on-ramps or off-ramps, or
- grade separated roads with:
 - posted speed limit greater than, or equal to 90 km/h, and
 - AADT greater than 20,000.
