Training Course (2 Days)

This is an introduction course for Learners who will be responsible for traffic management implementation on urban streets and low volume rural roads (Category 1). The course includes knowledge training and assessment, practical training and the South Australian Localised content training and assessment.

Post Course – to be completed within 6 months

Learners are required to gain and record practical work experience implementing traffic management plans. Examples include lane closure, lateral shift, managing traffic at an intersection and controlling site construction vehicles.

Learners can complete the practical work experience in their own workplace environment on the relevant Category type roads. For Learners who are not currently working, ATC will organise the practical placement for them with a Traffic Management Company approved by ATC.

Practical Assessment (½ Day)

On completion of the practical experience, Learners are required to successfully complete the Assessment on a live temporary traffic management site arranged by ATC. Learners will be assessed on their traffic implementation of 3 different traffic management set ups.

Small Learner groups hosted on a live ATC controlled TTM site, with separate ½ Day sessions scheduled to complete assessments.

Qualified TTM operators will be present to provide additional support and supervision to ensure a safe environment for the completion of individual assessments.

Course Outcome and Award

On successful completion of the assessment, Learners will be issued with:

- Statement of Attainment issued by ATC
- TTM card issued by DIT (Department for Infrastructure and Transport)

Course Content

- Communication techniques using equipment and systems
- Identify and assess risks and implement controls
- Prepare to implement traffic management plans
- Set out and monitor traffic guidance scheme
- Position, set up and program portable traffic control devices
- Operating portable traffic control devices and using signs to control traffic
- Shut down work activities and remove portable traffic control devices and signage

Learner Requirements

- Learners must hold the unit CPCCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry or its equivalent unit
- Ability to read, write, speak and understand English
- Learners must be at least 18 years of age
- Learners are required to be reaccredited every 3 years
